### **GUIDELINES FOR REVIEWERS**

Thank you for assisting the journal to assess a submission for publication. The following are suggested guidelines for structuring your assessment:

1. Please say whether you consider the submitted article makes a new contribution to knowledge in its field, or extends our understanding of its subject matter by its use of important new sources, approaches, or arguments. If so, please note the main ways in which you believe it achieves this.
2. Please make a brief assessment of any weaknesses in the piece, indicating in general where you believe more needs to be done to strengthen the argument(s) and suggesting any new sources, etc, that the author might use to address any problems you raise.
3. If you find the submitted article not publishable for reasons that mainly concern poor expression or confused argument, but with content you consider has the potential to make a real contribution to its field or usefully extend our understanding of its subject matter, please indicate this in your assessment. This question is of particular interest to the editors, who will endeavour to assist authors to bring potentially valuable submissions up to a publishable standard.
4. In addition to the foregoing, please feel free to add any comments you think relevant to a proper assessment of the scholarly value of the article submitted.
5. Finally, could you state whether you consider the submitted article should be:
  - Essentially published as it stands
  - Published with some modifications according to your suggestions
  - Published only after serious revision, along lines you indicate, and whether you require reassessment
  - Not published by this journal
6. We normally communicate reviewer's reports in an unedited and anonymous form to the author. However, if you wish to contact the author, we will make your identity known at the time, should you request it.
